## NEW BUILD HOUSE in INSITU CONCRETE

**Highbury, North London.** This new build house for a couple and their four children, is currently on site. The project is being built in exposed insitu concrete, (inside and out), with a predominantly glazed garden facade. Although the practice has worked in concrete before, we have enlisted the advice of concrete expert David Bennett, (author of *"Exploring Concrete Architecture"*), together with structural engineer Brian Eckersley, to ensure the success of our innovative approach. The project is now well underway with the groundworks complete and the first walls successfully struck. We eagerly await the completion of the building this summer.
